Scholarship Application

Members Financial Federal Credit Union will present scholarships annually. The credit union will award a total of three (3) \$750.00 scholarships this year. Members Financial Federal Credit Union Scholarships may be used for tuition at an accredited college, junior college, or university. Applicants must be within our field of membership who meet the following eligibility requirements and proofs of intent:

1. Applicant must be a **High School Senior or College Sophomore** in good standing.
- 2. Applicant must be a primary member in good standing of Members Financial FCU. Parent/legal guardian must be a primary member in good standing of Members Financial FCU.**
3. Recipient of scholarship funds must graduate from high school with a minimum GPA of 3.0. College student must have a minimum GPA of 3.0.
4. **Upon evidence of enrollment**, the \$750.00 scholarship fund will be paid by Members Financial Federal Credit Union to the member or the school of the recipient's choice.
5. Academic achievement, character, leadership, and personal recommendations will be considered in the selection of scholarship recipients.

If selected as a finalist, the applicant may be required to participate in a personal interview. Selections will be determined by a scholarship committee.

If the committee's first choice does not accept the scholarship, a second candidate will be selected.

No applicant's family member may serve on the selection committee.
