1. Please remember to change your password regularly.
2. Do not share your password with anyone.
3. Have a different password for each on-line account.
4. Write down your password and store it in a safe place away from your computer.
5. Passwords need to be long and strong—it's best not to use family member names, pets, birthdays, etc. This is easy for hackers to figure out. A best practice is to combine capital and lower case letters with numbers and symbols to create a more secure password.
6. Avoid logging into online banking accounts on public computers
7. Always lock you mobile phones via a passcode.
